In **JIGSAW** we will be:

Discussing being me in my world and how we all belong in our school and classes. We will also be celebrating differences between us and our classmates and learning about friendships.

As **WRITERS** we will be:

Developing our sentence structure by practising our sentences orally. We will learn how to record our sentences and improve them through shared writing as a class. We will try to apply our phonics we have already learnt and continue to use Read Write Inc phonics within our groups. We will be reminded to use capital letters, full stops and finger spaces in our writing and concentrate on letter formation.

As **READERS** we will be:

Making predictions and summarising books that we read together as a class. We will also be asking and answering questions about our class text. We will start to read books at home and school that are closely linked to our phonics level. Please listen to your child reading their book at home and read books to them for enjoyment.

In **P.E.** we will be:

We will be developing our dance and drama skills this term.

In **D&T** we will be: We will then focus on the Bonfire night celebration and create our own traditional Bonfire night food.

In **Science** we will be: learning about animals, including humans, and the different groups in which they belong. We will look at the features of different animals to understand how they are categorised. We hope to see some real animals to reinforce our learning.

In **Art** we will be: Learning about printing and what is involved with the technique, exploring a variety of materials. We will also look at prints by famous artists.

As **MATHEMATICIANS** we will be:

Continue to practise saying the numbers in order forwards and backwards with and without numbers to 100. Work on finding parts of a whole number.

We will continue to use numberblocks to support some mathematical ideas in the lessons.

In **GEOGRAPHY** we will be: learning about the weather we have in the UK and how we have different seasons. We will learn how the world has hot and cold places and think about what it would be like to live in these places.

In **HISTORY** we will be: Learning about Guy Fawkes and the role he played in British history. We will also be looking at how Guy Fawkes has influenced traditions of modern times.

In **R.E.** we will be: Learning about different religions and why and how they worship. We will look at different places of worship and visit the church.

In **MUSIC** we will be: listening to classical music and learning about composers.
