Thank you for your continued support, we look forward to seeing you in the Autumn term, bright and fresh in their smart uniforms.

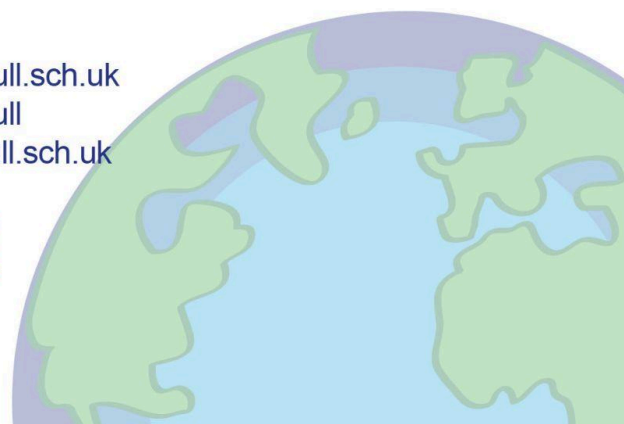
