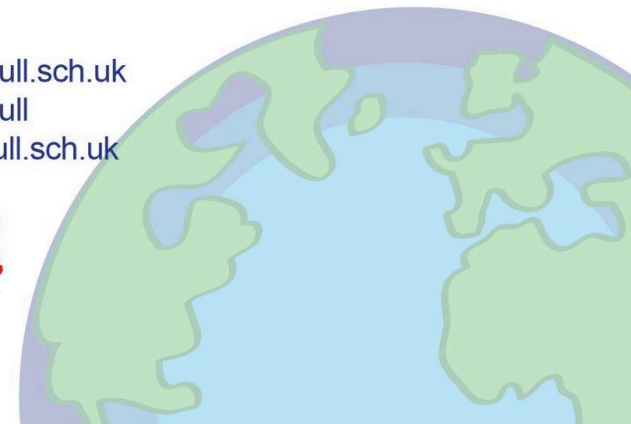

A free tool for parents to manage and protect their child's device.

WHAT IS GOOGLE FAMILY LINK?

- ✓ Approve or block apps you child wants to download
- ✓ Set screen time limits and daily phone schedules
- ✓ Block inappropriate websites and YouTube content
- ✓ Track your child's location
- ✓ Prevent them from deleting/bypassing controls without your permission

HOW TO SET IT UP:



Download the Family Link
app – Available for free on
Google Play Store and AppStore.

WHY USE IT?

Because it keeps your child safer

- Online predators
- Dangerous apps
- Harmful content
- Excessive screen time



- 1 Download the Family Link app – Available for free on the Google Play Store and Apple App Store.
- 2 Create a Google account for your child (if under 13–15). Use your own phone to manage the setup.
- 3 Link up child's device to your Family Link account
 - App approvals
 - Screen time limits
 - Website restrictions
 - Location tracking
 - Block harmful app like Tiktok, Snapchat, etc.

- 5 Monitor their activity anytime from your phone

- Online predators
 - Dangerous apps
 - Harmful content
 - Excessive screen time
- Start protecting your family today – it's free, easy, and life-changing.

If your child is over 13, they can request to stop supervision but you'll get a notification and can lock the phone again if needed.
