As **MATHEMATICIANS** we will be:

Able to rotate two lines around a fixed point to make different sized angles, draw triangles and quadrilaterals and identify vertices and be able to recognise a right angle in their environment. We will also look at weight and measurement.

As **WRITERS** we will be:

Using the story 'The Tunnel' to write diaries, letters and our own narratives based on the events in the book. We will also be writing about the Bronze Age and Iron Age to write information texts to inform others.

In **P.E.** we will be:

We will be working with the PE coaches to develop our moving, catching, stamina and learn about the effects of exercise on our bodies.

As **GEOGRAPHERS** we will be:

Learning about physical geography including mountains, earthquakes, volcanoes. We will be looking at how these are formed and what are the effects on humans living near them.

As **READERS** we will be:

Learning how to recognise and discuss the different features of a variety of texts, both fiction and non-fiction. We will have a continued focus on our home readers and using Accelerated Reader to show our progress.

In **DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY** we will be:

Researching, designing and creating our own Bronze Age houses using different techniques to join materials so they are strong.

In **R.E.** we will be:

Looking at different founders of faith and what makes a good leader. We will look at Moses, Abraham, Paul and Jesus.

In **HISTORY** we will be:

Learning about the changes in England between the Bronze Age and Iron Age. We will look at houses, clothes and weapons and how bronze was invented.

In **Spanish** we will be:

Recapping previous learning and learning how to say what subjects we are learning on each day.
