In Mathematics, we will:

Be continuing to develop verbal counting to 20 and beyond, including counting from different starting numbers to develop our confidence and accuracy. Explore the composition of odd and even numbers, looking at the 'shape' of these numbers and explore the composition of 10 using number bonds to support our understanding.

In Expressive Arts and Design, we will:

We will be creating and decorating our own crowns in celebration of the Coronation of King Charles Also developing our role-play skills through well-known stories and puppet performances. We will be also performing poems (from the poetry basket) with the assistance of instruments.

In Physical Development, we will:

Practise throwing, catching and rolling different objects to our partners.

Learn how to work as a team when playing games.

In Understanding of the World, we will:

Develop our understanding of the wider world further by looking at differences in our community and school.

We will be talking about changes we have noticed from the beginning of the year and how we have developed and grown to transition into Year 1.

In Mathematics, we will:

Be deepening the children's developing automaticity with some number facts such as knowing that whole amounts can be split into parts.

-Know that parts can be combined to make whole amounts, and that the whole is larger than each of its parts

-Know the different 'numbers within' 10, and naming the parts that make the whole number, e.g. that 10 is composed of 5 and 5, or 6 and 4 and knowing doubles facts up to '5 and 5 make 10'.
