## How can we show we care?

In **JIGSAW** we will be:

focusing on our relationships. Firstly thinking about our own families and how varied they can be before thinking about our friendships in and out of school.

As **WRITERS** we will be:

Using our phonics to help sound out and spell words. We will write clear sentences including capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. We will try make our writing more interesting by adding adjectives and use our imagination to write longer stories inspired by the books we will read. These will include: Zog and the Flying Doctors, The Smartest Giant in Town, Where the Wild Things are, Jack and the Beanstalk and some non-fiction texts about growing plants.

As **READERS** we will be: Continuing to use Read Write inc phonics within our groups to practise our reading regularly and develop our fluency.

We will be making predictions and answering questions about our class text connected to our topic of caring.

In **P.E.** we will be:

Developing our striking and fielding skills in pairs and small groups.

This will focus on developing throwing and catching skills as well as learning to work as a team.

In **D&T** we will be: researching, designing, creating and evaluating lanterns.

In **Science** we will be: investigating what plants need to grow.

In **Art** we will be: using Vincent Van Gogh's 'Sunflowers' painting to inspire our own masterpieces.

As **MATHEMATICIANS** we will be:

Working with numbers 11-20. Firstly looking at how they are made of '10 and a bit' and understanding their position on numberlines before using these numbers in addition and subtraction problems. We will continue to practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

In **GEOGRAPHY** we will be: learning about the different continents and oceans in the world.

In **HISTORY** we will be: learning about Florence Nightingale, Mary Seacole and Edith Cavell. We will find about the important work they did and how it still matters today.

In **R.E.** we will: thinking why is the world special? We will look at some creation stories and think how we can all care for our world.

In **MUSIC** we will be: listening to 50s rock and roll. We will be appraising and comparing music with a focus on performance.
